

Legion, Town honour veterans with banner program

The Royal Canadian Legion and the Town of Aurora are coming together this fall to honour the Town's veterans with a six-week long flag campaign celebrating and recognizing the achievements and sacrifices of those who have served their country.

The Honour Our Veterans Banner Program will see 44 banners lining the streets of historic, downtown Aurora from October 1, 2016 to November 12, 2016. Each banner will display the name of the veteran or active service member, a photo of him/her in uniform, the era of service, branch of service, and the name of the organization sponsoring the banner.
