In addition, as a member of Team Ontario at Eastern Canadian Championships, he earned a gold medal on Pommel and silver medals on Rings & Parallel Bars.

Senior team member Alex Stefanidis, also competed at Level 3, and in a year marked with huge improvements, earned bronze medals on Pommel, Parallel Bars and All Around.
