

Jays down early in NDBL semifinals

The Aurora Jays find themselves in a hole after suffering their first loss of the North Dufferin Baseball League playoffs. Facing the second-seeded Bolton Brewers after a first round sweep of the Ivy Leafs, the Jays fell 7 - 4 in Game One of the semifinal series held Sunday at North Hill Park in Bolton.

Devon Wu was on the mound for the Jays.

The best-of-five series continued Tuesday evening at Lambert Willson Park in Aurora following press time, and will continue Thursday evening back in Bolton with a first pitch time of 7:30 p.m.

If necessary, the series will swing back to Lambert Willson on Saturday for Game Four, with Game Five tentatively scheduled for Sunday.
