This Friday, November 7, York Regional Police will host their fourth annual Remembrance Day Ceremony. This commemoration will get underway at 11 a.m. at the #3 District Headquarters at 3527 Baseline Road in Sutton.

Here in Aurora, Remembrance Week will be marked with the annual Veterans Dinner hosted by the Royal Canadian Legion (105 Industrial Parkway North), which gets underway at 6 p.m. This evening's guest speaker is Lt.
