### Canada Summer Jobs Program

Are you interested in hiring students this coming summer? The Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) application period is now open! I encourage not-for-profit organizations, public sector employers and small businesses to apply for funding through the CSJ. This unique federal funding initiative helps employers create summer job opportunities for students. Faced with high unemployment and underemployment, many young people have difficulty finding valuable work experience. It is time to invest in young Canadians to ensure they can begin their careers and contribute fully to our economy. Please note that the application period for employers will run from January 4 to February 26, 2016, which will allow students to be hired beginning May 2016. ### CanExport

The Federal Government is introducing a new program called CanExport which will provide \$50 million to help small and medium sized enterprises across the country take advantage of global export opportunities. CanExport will benefit hundreds of Canadian small businesses each year through matching contributions of between \$10,000 and \$100,000 towards export development costs. This is a key part of our government's commitment to help Canadian companies succeed abroad while creating good-quality jobs and growth at home. Companies with fewer than 250 employees and between \$200,000 and \$50 million of annual revenue in Canada are eligible to apply for this initiative. Applications are available online at [international.gc.ca/canexport](http://international.gc.ca/canexport) and funding is available immediately.
