

Panthers teams in hunt for Lower Lakes championships

An impressive eight Aurora Panthers squads have moved on to the second round of the Lower Lakes Female Hockey League playdowns.

The Midget A Panthers, the highest level of play to move on to the quarterfinals, earned their ticket to the second round last week with a pair of shutout wins over the Vaughan Flames. The Atom BBs round out the playoff competition with a second round series against the Barrie Sharks, winning game one 2 ? 1 before falling in game two 2 ? 0 to send the series to a third and deciding game.
